

Minor in EES (15 credits)

Our minor is designed for students wishing to explore an area of Earth or Environmental Sciences in conjunction with a major program in another field. You might choose to do this for career enhancement or for personal development. This minor would pair up beautifully with a B.A. major in Environmental Studies.

The requirements for the minor in EES are incredibly simple. You simply need to earn a total of 15 credits in EES, with one credit coming from the integrated introductory laboratory (EES 22). In practice, EES 22 requires any one of our introductory-level EES "gateway" courses as a prerequisite or co-requisite, so a complete listing of the minor requirements would be:

1. Take any introductory-level EES course for three credits.
2. Take the EES integrated introductory laboratory (EES 22) for one credit.
3. Take additional EES courses to bring your EES total up to at least 15 credits.

Internship and research credits count towards the total, as do any EES College Seminars (EES 90) that are designated as natural science (NS).
